

Cookies Usage

1. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that a website puts on your computer, phone or any other device with internet access, which contains information about the navigation on that website. Cookies do not harm your computer; they are useful for providing an easy navigation and make it friendlier.

2. What is the purpose of cookies on Mobile Jazz web site?

The main purpose of our cookies is to improve your browsing experience on our website. For example, cookies can help identify you (in case you are registered in our website), to remember your preferences during navigation and during future visits.

The information collected by the cookies also allows us to implement improvements in the web, using estimates on patterns and numbers, this way we can adapt the web site to the interests of each user, etc.

The cookies used by our website do not store sensitive personal identification information such as your address, your password, data on your credit card, etc... We do not use cookies to target advertising to our users based on their browsing or for other advertising purposes, nor own or third parties.

3. Who uses the information stored in cookies?

The information stored in cookies from our website is used exclusively by us, except for those of Google Analytics, which are used and managed by Google and by us for statistical purposes. [Click here for more information.](#)

4. Can you disable the use of cookies?
